## 2022-2023 Grade 12 Course Selection Guidelines

Please note that these guidelines are for current Grade 11 students in mainstream classes at Kenner CVI. International Baccalaureate students will be provided with IB specific guidelines to ensure that their course selections meet IB programme requirements.

1. All students must register for SEVEN (7) or EIGHT (8) courses. Most Grade 12 Students will have earned enough credits to date to allow for at least one spare period, but you still must choose seven or eight courses.
2. All students must choose a Grade 12 English Class at their current level of study.
